

# INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

The purpose of this instruction sheet is to illustrate the manufacturer's recommended installation of the 2009 Ford F-150 Leg Kit.

1. Begin by removing the center console or middle seat of the 2009 Ford F-150. Take note of the metal bracket that the seat mounts to. The leg kit will also mount to this bracket.
2. Using the same hardware removed with the seat or center console, mount the Front Leg, as oriented in FIG. 1, to the hole-pattern on the floor of the transmission hump and nearest the front of the vehicle.
3. Again, using the same hardware, mount the two Rear Legs, as oriented in FIG. 1, to the metal bracket in the same manner that the seat/console was mounted.
4. Assuring that all fasteners are secure, the installation of the 2009 Ford F-150 Leg Kit is complete. Add a top plate, console package, or pole mounted solution to complete the project.

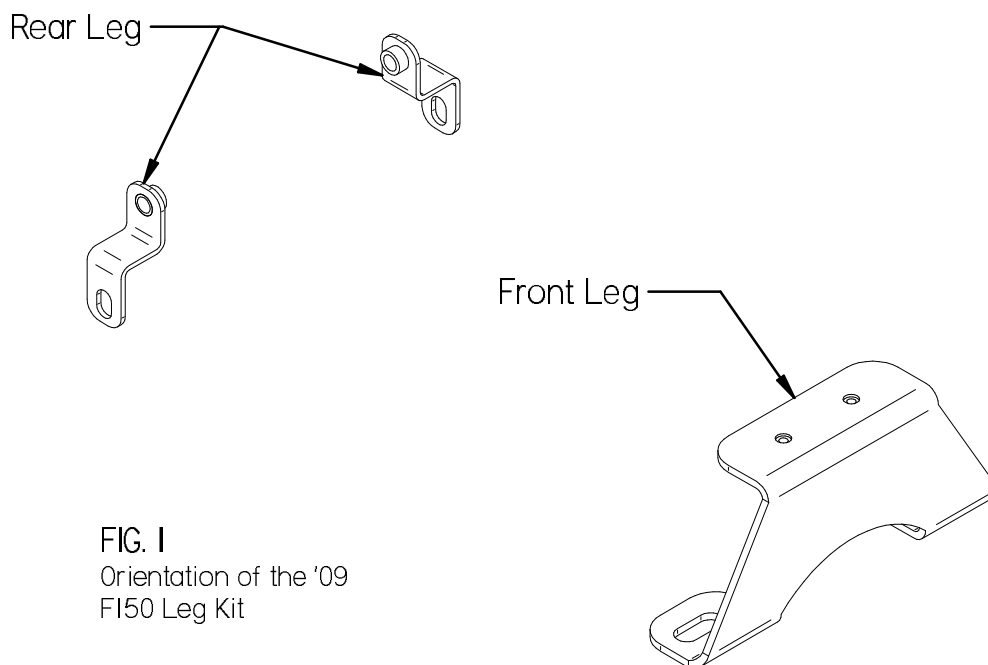
