

- I. Remove the four seat bolts on the front passenger's seat (Figure I).
- 2. Remove the passenger seat or lean it back onto the rear seats.
- 3. Lay the vehicle base on the frame cross member so that the square holes are approximately centered on the flooring cutouts (Figure 2).
- 4. Place the seat back into position on top of the vehicle base.
- 5. Verify the seat rails are lined up into the square holes in the vehicle base. The base should run parallel to the frame cross member.
- 6. Reinstall the four factory seat bolts.
- 7. Four 3/8-16 x .75" bolts, washers and lock washers are provided to mount a pole to the threaded inserts.


