






Install

1. Remove OEM center console or center seat following instructions provided in the vehicle specific Factory Service Manual (FSM)


*If vehicle is equipped with a center HVAC vent it is recommended that this vent be covered using aluminum flashing tape.

*If vehicle was equipped with center console, additional trim panels may be required to provide the best fit for the Gamber-Johnson console.

*If relocating the OEM USB module, refer to the diagram below:



NOTE: If the vehicle was not equipped with a center seat or center console, the console mounting holes may need to be tapped (M12-1.75) and the console fastened using the hardware provided.



*Before installing seat bolts, loosely attach driver and passenger side wings to the console with provided #10 hardware (FIGURE 2).

3. The console can be attached to the vehicle with the OEM hardware (FIGURE 3 & FIGURE 4). Torque bolts to OEM specification per FSM.

4. The driver and passenger side wings can now be adjusted to fit against interior trim panels.

5. Electronics Tray

- a. The included electronics tray can be populated outside of console installation.
- b. Once ready to install the electronics tray, the #10 hardware holding the angled face of the console must be removed, followed by the angled face itself. (FIGURE 7)
- c. Install the electronics tray on the 4 threaded studs on the interior of the console box.
- d. Secure the electronics tray using the provided 1/4-20 Nyloc nuts. (FIGURE 8)
- e. Reinstall the angled face of the console.
