
INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Product Leg Kit - Universal Flat Floor MCS

Revision

The universal flat floor leg kit can be used with 9", 14", and 18" console boxes mounted on either the short or long top plate.

- 1. Place the top plate in the desired position on the floor of the vehicle. It may be necessary to temporarily mount the console box, pole, or other options to determine the best location for the top plate.
- 2. Install the leg kit to any of the mounting holes on the vertical flanges of the top plate using hardware provided. (Note: wide spacing of legs provides greater stability.) Adjust location of legs to suit equipment mounted below the vehicle floor. Mark the mounting hole location, and note whether it will be necessary to shim any leg with washers to compensate for floor irregularities.
- 3. Drill 17/32" (.53") holes in the floor at each mounting location, using care not to damage any equipment that may be under the floor.
- 4. Place the bolts in holes, and nuts and washers, and tighten, (hardware not provided by Gamber-Johnson LLC). If the floor is less than 1/4" thick, we recommend using fender washers on the bottom side. Do not use lag screws or sheet metal screws as they can pull out of the floor.
