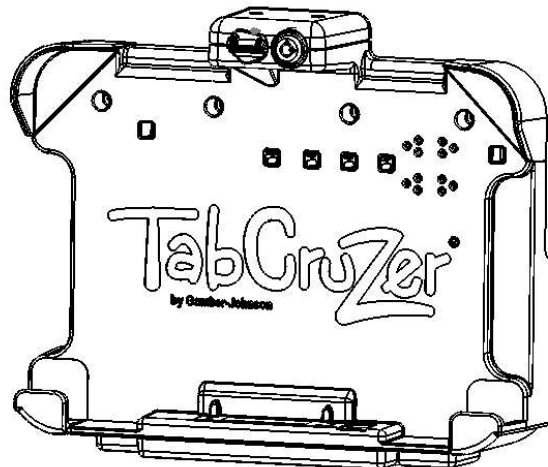

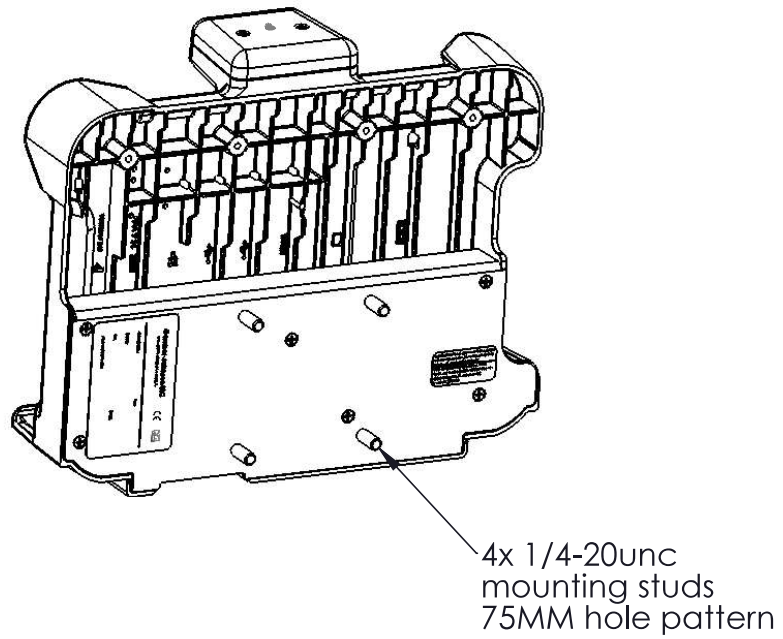
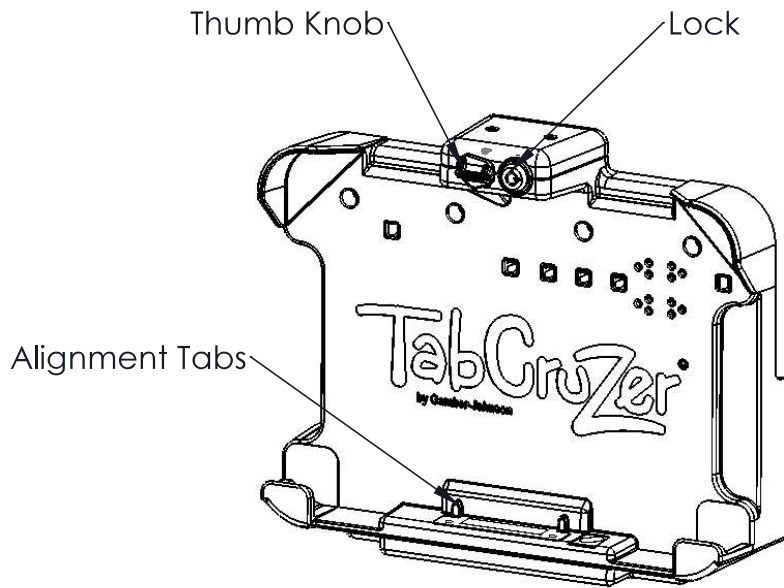

INSERTING THE COMPUTER

1. Insert the bottom of the computer into the cradle.

Then rotate the top of the computer under the top latch until the computer is resting inside the main housing. The latch will spring down in front of the computer to hold it in place. (see Figures 1 & 2)

3. (Optional) The key lock can now be used for security purposes.

TO REMOVE THE COMPUTER

1. Unlock if locked.

3. Push upward on the thumb knob and pull outward on the top of the computer until it clears the top latch. Lift the computer out of the cradle. (See figure 3)
